



MOU between Lloyd's Register and Korea Occupational Safety and Health Agency (KOSHA)

Lloyd's Register Verification Limited and KOSHA have agreed to enter into agreement for technical cooperation in the field of pressure equipment and devices. The occasion was graced by Richard Sadler, CEO of Lloyd's Register Group, and Hun-Ki, Baek, President of KOSHA

Both parties agreed to pursue collaboration in testing, evaluation and inspection results for certification of KC Mark and European Directives. The purpose of the agreement aims at establishing and maintaining official cooperation for the benefit of industrial safety for pressure equipment and devices. KOSHA will support the domestic companies which need to obtain CE Certificate in accordance with European Directives while Lloyds Register will support the manufacturers in overseas countries which need to obtain KC Mark in accordance with Korean Industrial Safety and Health Act. Lloyd's Register and KOSHA have also agreed to expand the scope of agreement to including industrial safety and health.
